WAITING ON GOD

ISAIAH 40:27-31

NOVEMBER 27TH, 2022

Waiting on God means...

- I. Rehearsing truth concerning God's greatness: vs. 27-28
Four aspects of God's greatness:
 - a. God is the eternal everlasting God
 - b. God is the Creator of all
 - c. God is constantly working
 - d. God is all wise
- II. Seeking spiritual strength from God: vs. 29-30
- III. Hoping God will come through: vs. 31

Questions:

1. Go around and have everyone share why waiting (in general, not just on God) is so challenging for you personally.
2. What does it mean that "Waiting is what it means to be a Christian"? As a follow up, why is observing the Advent season so important and how do you plan to participate in Advent this year?
3. Isaiah 40:27-31 teach us to wait on God in three ways. Which of the three was most helpful to you and why?
 - Rehearsing truth concerning God's greatness: vs. 27-28
 - Seeking spiritual strength from God: vs. 29-30
 - Hoping God will come through: vs. 31
4. Assign each person in the group (or assign by couples) one of the following Scriptures. Give them 5 minutes to answer this question, "What does this passage teach us about waiting?" and then have each person share with the whole group.
 - Psalm 27:14
 - Psalm 37:7
 - Lamentations 3:25-26
 - Isaiah 30:18
 - Psalm 130:5-6
 - Psalm 33:20-22
 - Isaiah 64:4
