Why study the Gospels?

- They give us the most concentrated exposure to God's kingdom.
- They bring the truth to life.

What is the message of the Gospels?

- The gospel is the proclamation that God's long-awaited kingdom of restoration has finally been inaugurated in Christ and will be completed at his return.

How should we read the Gospels?

- As the biblical center point, not midpoint
- Vertically, not horizontally

Who is Jesus according to the Gospels?

- Matthew: the promised Messiah
- Mark: the suffering Servant
- Luke: the Savior of the world
- John: the Son of God
