

Snacks and Discussion Questions

Goal: To use snack time as a time to review previous lessons, ask discussion questions from that day's lesson, and connect with the kids. The listed questions are simply a guide. Feel free to ask your own!

There will also be hand sanitizer at your station and water bottles each day.

Day One: Dirt Pudding

Pudding will be made before club. You will need to add gummy worms to each cup.

Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. What are the four types of soils in Jesus' parable of the Sower and the Seeds? Path (hard, packed soil), rocky soil, thorny soil (full of weeds), and good soil.
- 2. What does the seed represent in the Sower and the Seed Parable? The Word of God
- 3. What does the good soil represent in the Parable of the Sower and the Seed? Those with obedient hearts who hear and understand the word and try to obey it.
- 4. Who enters God's Kingdom? (Those who believe in Jesus)

Day Two: Trail Mix-popcorn, pretzels, marshmallows, m and m's, goldfish

Put the ingredients in separate bowls. Each child gets a snack baggie. Help them scoop each ingredient into the baggies.

*Review Questions from previous day.

Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. Who were the Pharisees?
- 2. How did the Pharisees react to Jesus eating with sinners?
- 3. What did the Shepherd do when he found his lost sheep?
- 4. How are we like sheep?
- 5. Why is Jesus like the Good Shepherd?

Day Three: Popsicles

*For clubs with animals coming, popsicles should be given to the kids during lesson time. The snack time on the rotation will be when the kids get to spend time with the animals.

*Review Question from previous day.

Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. What did the wise man build his house upon? The Rock
- 2. What did the foolish man build his house upon? The Sand
- 3. In our lives, who is really the Rock? Jesus
- 4. What happens when we build our life upon the rock? We stand on the knowledge of Jesus and He will help us to stand firm and not fall down.
- 5. What happens when we build our life upon the sand? When life gets hard we will fall.
- 6. What is wisdom? Answers may vary. Wisdom is doing what is right in the sight of the Lord.
- 7. What are some of the things that we can do to gain wisdom? Read our Bibles, pray, attend Church, listen to our parents and teachers, etc.
- 8. Will you build your life on the rock or on the sand? Answers will vary. Use this as a discussion question, more than a question with a right or wrong answer.

Day Four: Packaged baggies of chips or pretzels or animal crackers.

Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. What are the two most important commandments in God's Law?
- 2. How did the priest and Levite respond to the injured man on the road?
- 3. Who was a true neighbor to the injured man? Why?
- 4. Can anyone obey the law perfectly?
- 5. How can we receive eternal life?
